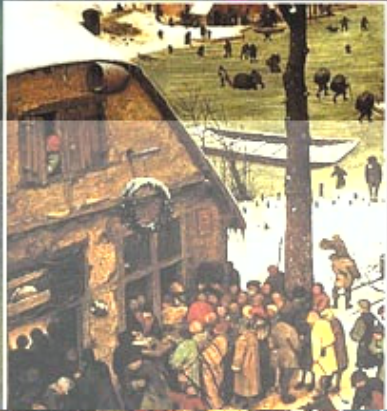

We are a friendly choir working to high standards with professional musicians. We always give a warm welcome to new singers. If you would like to sing with us:

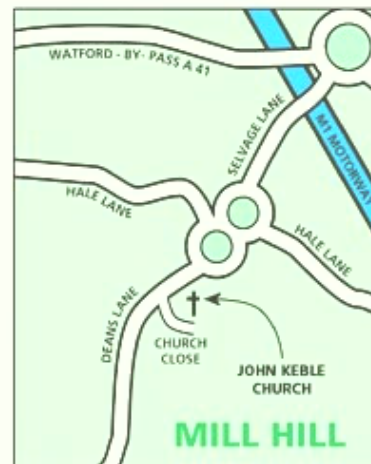
- Come to our sing in (13th September)

The London Pro Arte Choir is pleased to be launching its second season under its musical director, Robin Kimber. Its reputation for excellence is well established; in past years the choir has forged a welcome link with the Mill Hill Music Festival as well as making John Keble Church its home.

Last season the choir added works by Saint-Saens, Handel, Brahms Haydn and Elgar to its repertoire; next season it looks forward to the challenge of unfamiliar pieces by Puccini, Bach and Pergolesi, as well as returning to popular works by Duruflé and Rossini. The choir performs concerts with young professional soloists as well as some of London's finest musicians.

During the past year there has been a welcome expansion in membership (especially tenors), an increase in musical skills, and a positive response to the challenges of new repertoire. New members have found the choir welcoming, and have been attracted



by the well focussed rehearsals, and the rewards which that can bring. Voice tapes are provided for those whose sight-reading isn't 100%, which reduces the time spent on note-bashing. There is no formal audition but a certain degree of musical literacy is assumed.

Robin Kimber has spent most of his professional life involved in music in Oxford and London. In the past year he has made two CDs and toured in Austria, Belgium and the Lake District. He is delighted with the choir's progress over the past year and is pleased to be involved in this new season of music-making with them.
