We are a friendly choir working to high standards with professional musicians. We always give a warm welcome to new singers. If you would like to sing with us:

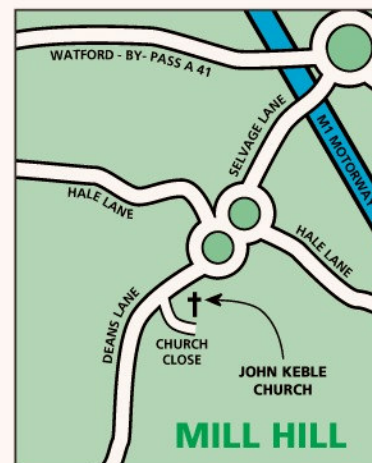

The London Pro Arte Choir is delighted to launch another new season under its musical director, Robin Kimber. Its reputation for excellence is well established; in past years the choir has forged a welcome link with the Mill Hill Music Festival as well as making John Keble Church its home.

In past seasons the choir has added new works by Pergolesi, Brahms, Saint-Saens and Puccini to its repertoire; next year it meets the challenge of unfamiliar music by Elgar, Buxtehude and Mozart as well as returning to popular works by Fauré and Dvorak.

The choir continues to grow in numbers; new members have found the choir welcoming, and attracted by the well focused rehearsals. Voice tapes are provided for those whose reading isn't 100%, which saves valuable rehearsal time. There is no formal audition but a certain degree of musical literacy is assumed.

Robin Kimber has spent most of his professional life involved in music in Oxford and London. He has recently made two CDs and toured in France and Austria. He looks forward to this new season with the choir and is delighted to be involved in music-making with them.
