The London Pro Arte Choir is proud to present another season under the musical direction of Robin Kimber. The reputation of the choir continues to grow: last season it sang Chilcott's Jubilate and gave a concert performance of Gershwin's Porgy & Bess.

The repertoire of the choir is widening and the coming season will include new delights by Haydn, lenkins and Poulenc.

The choir has grown steadily under Robin's baton. New members have found a warm welcome awarting them, and have been encouraged by well-focused rehearsals, adroitly accompanied by Paul Ayres. Although there is no formal audition, a certain degree of musical literacy is assumed. For those less confident with sightreading, voice tapes are available.

Robin Kimber has spent most of his professional life involved with music in London and Oxford. He looks forward to the challenges of guiding the choir through this year's programme and is delighted to be leading them in another new season of music making.
