London Pro Arte Choir welcomes new members. Rehearsals are on Thursday evenings 7.30 – 10pm at St Michael's, Flower Lane.



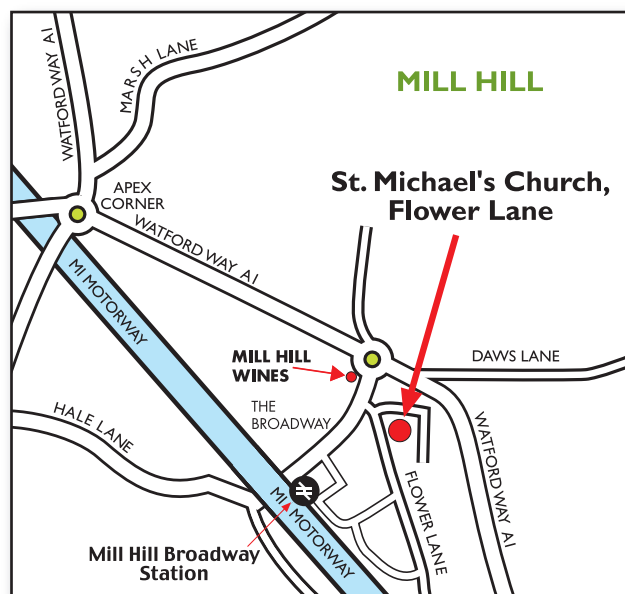
Our accompanist, Elizabeth Shepherd, supports our weekly rehearsals and CDs of individual parts are available to help learning notes.

Written in memory of his mother, the *Requiem* breathes French Romanticism and includes the poignant *Pie Jesu*.
